Over the next five weeks we will be learning and celebrating what it means to live missionally. The theme for this series is "My 95," based on the idea that, at most, we spend 5% of our time in church – so how are we living the other 95% of our time? Living missionally is about integrating the Gospel into all the environments where we spend time: our relationships, neighborhood, work, school, and city.

The same principle applies to our finances. We will hold our annual pledge campaign during the "My 95" series so that we can also consider what it means to live missionally with our money. All that we have is a gift from God, and His generosity towards us allows us to give freely to His work.

We will soon send you a pledge card and more information about how pledging benefits both you and CPC.
